<u>How to Help Your Middle School Child</u> <u>Succeed in Math</u>

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- 1. Have a positive attitude about math. NEVER tell your child that you hate math (even if you do).
- 2. Make sure that your child is completing his/her math homework EVERY night.
- 3. Ask your child what they are learning about in math class.
- 4. Do logic puzzles and or Sudoku puzzles with your child.
- 5. When shopping with your child, have him/her estimate the cost, including tax. Once you pay, have a discussion about why their guess was over or under the actual amount.
- 6. Discuss the ways in which you use math every day in real life.
- 7. Keep in touch with your child's math teacher. Ask if there is anything you can/should be doing at home with your child.
- 8. Study with your child.
- 9. Do math homework with your child. You may not need to know the answers, but have your child explain how you begin a question, and problem solve together when you are stuck.
- 10. Go out and eat and have your child calculate the tip.

11. When you are in the car, have your child estimate the time until arrival at your destination.
